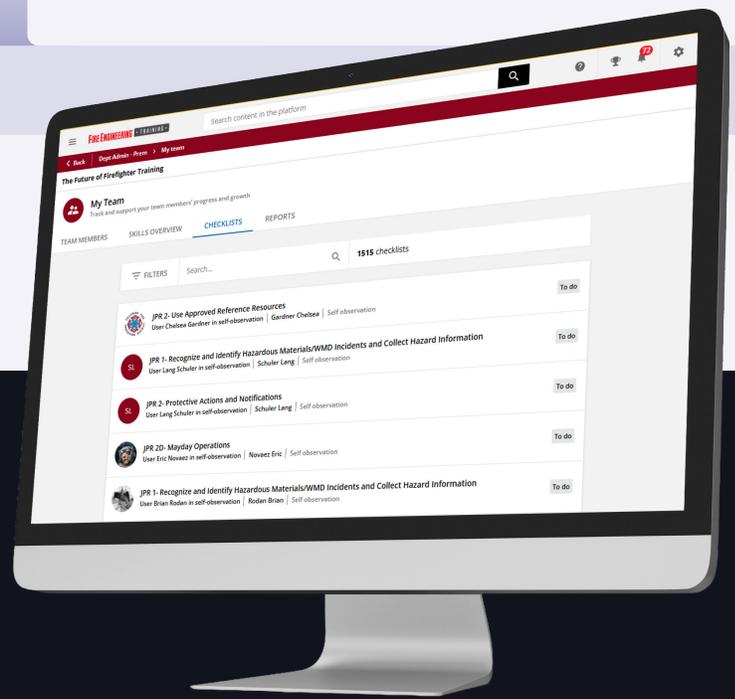

# SIMPLE, EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION ▶

## PROVIDED LIGHT GUIDANCE

A short demonstration of the tool and Fire Engineering Training resources helped users quickly adapt to the system.

2

## INTRODUCED INDIVIDUAL SKILL TRACKING

Firefighters were instructed to log their own Job Performance Requirements (JPRs), ensuring personal accountability.

## SCHEDULED DAILY ASSIGNMENTS

Checklists were assigned on a shift-by-shift basis to keep firefighters engaged and on track.

## SET UP APPROVAL WORKFLOW

Submitted checklists were routed for review and verified against training submissions in External Training.

## SCALED THEIR DOCUMENTATION

Recreated paper taskbooks as courses with embedded checklists.

# WHY IT WORKED ▶



## NO TECH BARRIERS

Accessible on desktop and in the mobile app



## FLEXIBLE USE

Checklists were used for skills, surveys, and performance reviews



## MINIMAL TRAINING REQUIRED

Most users, regardless of age, picked it up with ease



## QUICK SETUP

Courses and taskbooks were duplicated and reused with minimal effort



## DAILY SCHEDULING

Shift-based checklist assignments kept firefighters on track
